GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Evaluation:** All athletes will receive adjudication sheets for all individual events. No scores or placings will be given.
- 2. Costumes:** Not required as this is a "practice" competition.
- 3. Refunds:** Refunds are not given unless a medical certificate is presented.
- 4. Music:** The International Cup music will be used for Solo, 2-Baton and 3-Baton. CBTF official music will be used for the Pre competitive events. Competition music can be purchased through the SBTA office.
- 5. Order of the Events:** Opening procession, Pre-competitive events (*Basic march, Forward Motion, Pre Medley, Pre Solodance, Pre Solo, Pre Two Baton*), CBTF Events (*Medley, Solo, Two Baton, Solodance*), Novelty events. The set system will be used.
- 6. S.B.T.A. /C.B.T.F. Membership** - each participant and their coach(es) must be a 2011/2012 member of the Saskatchewan Baton Twirling Association. At minimum, a recreational (BR) membership is required to participate in this event. If you require a membership, please contact your club President.
