Re: NEW MEMBER INCENTIVE GRANT

The Saskatchewan Baton Twirling Association (SBTA) is pleased to announce a new incentive program that is designed to help grow the sport of baton twirling in our province. SBTA is an organization that encourages and develops the widest participation and the highest proficiency of Baton Twirling in Saskatchewan.

The *New Member Incentive Grant* will provide funding in the amount of \$20 for every \$10 recreational athlete membership taken out by your students. The grant can be used for a wide variety of things that will help grow your baton program including new stereo equipment, newspaper advertising, or new batons, for example.

For studios/clubs that register a minimum of 15 members (this could be all twirlers or a mixture of twirlers, parents, and volunteers) an additional bonus grant of \$250 will be made available.

For example:

- If you register 10 students and 1 instructor, you will receive a \$200 *New Member Incentive Grant*.
- If you register 10 students, 1 instructor, and 4 parent volunteers, you will receive the *New Member Incentive Grant* of \$200, plus the bonus grant of \$250 for having more than 15 registered members – a total of \$450 in grant money in return for \$150 worth of memberships!

In addition to the *New Member Incentive Grant*, the SBTA offers a wide variety of programs and services that can directly benefit you and your twirlers.

Application Requirements and Procedures:

- 1 – #103 SBTA recreational "New Member" form for each athlete (Type BR).
 - 1 – #103 SBTA coach membership form for each coach/instructor (Type C).
 - 1 – #103 SBTA volunteer membership form for all other members/parents (Type E).
 - 1 – Single payment for the above memberships
- 1 – New Member Incentive Grant Application form.
