OPEN COMPETITION - GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. C.B.T.F. Rules and Regulations (effective Jan. 1, 2012) are in effect and will be strictly enforced. Please check with your coach or Provincial Technical Chairperson if you are unsure of C.B.T.F. rules.
2. Judges decisions are final. Tabulation results are considered official after 48 hours.
3. Sponsors reserve the right to divide or combine age divisions as entries warrant. The broadest divisions used are: 4-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18+ and in no case will a division be run with ages combined beyond these limits.
4. Classification = Type of event; Division = Age; Status Level = C, BN, BI, or A.
LEVEL Graded C & BN: (ages 7-11) A Diamond award will advance a Level C competitor to BN or a Level BN competitor to BI.
LEVEL C : (ages 12 & up) A score of 2.5 or greater will advance a Level C competitor to BN regardless of placement.
LEVEL BN: (ages 12 & up) A score of 4.0 or greater will advance a Level BN competitor to BI regardless of placement.
LEVEL BI : A score of 6.0 or greater will advance a Level BI competitor to Level A regardless of placement.
LEVEL A : one who does not qualify in the above.
5. Any Level BN or Level BI who enters a Level A Championship classification and competes will automatically become Level A status in that classification regardless of placing.
6. **Change of Status:** Due to advancement at competitions held after the deadline date, proof of advancement date must be received by the entry processor or competition director no later than 48 hours after the competition results in which advancement takes place other wise the change will be categorized as late and will not be accepted. The claim must be substantiated by a result tabulation master/score sheet or written official results substantiated/signed by the competition director. The SBTA will notify registrars of athletes that move-up in their status level.
7. **Refunds** will not be given unless a medical certificate is presented – no exceptions.
8. **Awards**
 - o Pre-Medley, Pre-Solodance twirl, Pre-Solo, Pre 2-baton, Forward Motion, Basic March, Pre-Groups – Ribbons.
 - o Level C & BN Graded Divisions (ages 7-11) Solo, 2-baton, 3-baton, Duet (combined ages 14-22), Medley, Solodance twirl, Compulsories - Diamond, Gold, Silver and Bronze awards.
 - o Level C & BN (ages 12 & up) Solo, 2-baton, 3-baton, Duet (combined ages 23 & up), Medley, Solodance twirl, Compulsories - 1st to 3rd place medals.
 - o Levels BI & A (all ages) Solo, 2-baton, 3-baton, Duet, Medley, Solodance twirl, Compulsories/Short program 1st to 3rd place medals.
 - o Group Competition Level C, B & A -1st to 3rd will receive an award.

** C & BN (ages 12 & up), BI & A divisions with 10+ competitors will receive 4th and 5th place ribbons **
9. The set system and flash card system may be implemented.
10. **Duet Twirl** - Age Divisions (combined ages of both athletes) – Status Level: two athletes who have not competed in duet together before must start in Level 'C', otherwise status is determined by CBTF Duet Status from previous results.
11. **S.B.T.A./C.B.T.F. Membership** - Each athlete and their coach(es) must be a 2011/2012 member of their own provincial organization to compete in a C.B.T.F. sanctioned event. Athletes must have a number prior to entering. **Do not send membership fee with competition entry form.** If you need more information, contact:

12. Video Taping - Contact Competition Director prior to competition date to discuss video taping fee and designated location.
13. "All Athletes" will receive score sheets or critique sheets for individual and duet events.
14. **Medical Apparel/apparatus:** Athletes wearing tensor bandages, etc. at a competition may be asked to provide a medical certificate PRIOR TO COMPETING stating that the athlete can participate in the competition event. The Competition Director (in consulting with the Head Judge) has the authority to refuse to allow an athlete to compete if a medical certificate is not provided.
15. **ERRORS OR OMISSIONS** on entry form will be corrected by a COLLECT telephone call to the entrant.
16. **CBTF (Canadian Baton Twirling Federation) RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY**
 1. The Competition Director or Designate will have the authority to immediately stop the competition whenever a risk factor related to safety becomes evident.
 2. If this situation occurs during individual competition, the competition on the lane where the situation occurs will be stopped on the lane only.
 3. If an athlete has to leave the competition to seek outside medical assistance because of a situation that has occurred during a competition, they will require a medical certificate in order to continue competing.
